

BSDH Events Privacy Policy Statement

In compliance with the most recent GDPR, how we collect, store and use your data is defined below.

What information we hold

We hold the details you provided when you registered to attend a BSDH event

Name

GDC / GMC registration number

Email address

Postal address

Telephone number(s)

How, and when your attendance fee was paid (eg direct debit, PayPal, credit card or cheque)

We do not retain any sensitive financial information.

What we use the information for

BSDH (via Hay Green Education (HGE) Ltd) will use your contact details to facilitate your attendance of the BSDH event you registered for. We will email you with information you will need in advance of attending the event and any information you may need after the event. Also, after the event we will contact you to invite you to join a mailing list to receive updates about BSDH events.

How we store the information

Your BSDH event registration details are stored on a cloud based database, and with 'MailChimp', a US based email service compliant with the new European GDPR. The event registration information on the BSDH website is stored on a server in Europe managed by '1and1' who are also compliant with GDPR. All data is password protected and encrypted at all three locations.

We do not keep paper records of your registration information. The signed event registers are retained as paper copies in secure filing. They are also scanned, and password protected to be filed electronically as a permanent record of your attendance of the event.

How long we will keep the information

We will keep your registration information for five years after the date of the event you attended.

If you do not attend the event you registered for we will delete your registration information immediately after the course dates.

Records of payment amount, method and date will be kept for seven years to fulfil accounting requirements, and will then be deleted.

The signed event registers will be retained as a permanent record of your attendance of the event.
