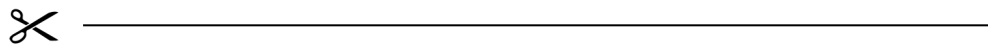

**Friday 5th April 2019**

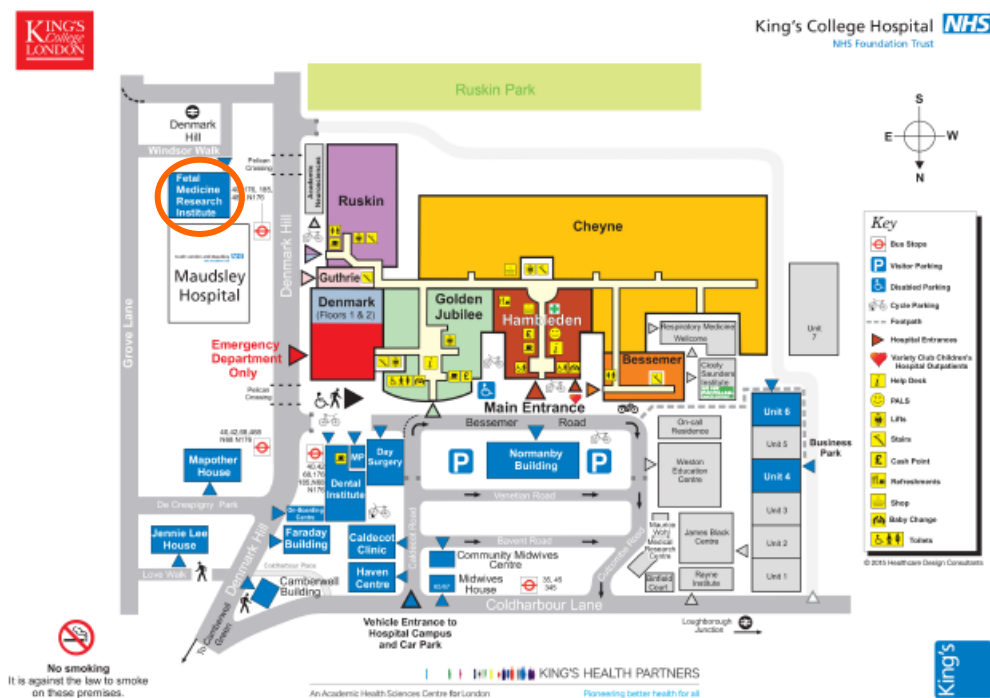
This course will provide clinicians working within primary and secondary care with the relevant knowledge to provide safe dental care to patients with diabetes
